Itinerary Sunrice Festival – Leeton Tour

Day 1. Thursday 29 March 2018: Home – Narrandera

This morning we pick you up from home and travel south on the Southern Motorway and west on the Sturt Highway to Narrandera with lunch and comfort stops along the way.

Day 2. Friday 30 March 2015

After breakfast this morning we arrive at the **Leeton Tourist Information Centre** to start our **Driving Guided Tour** with a local guide. After the tour we sample local produce. The “**Tastes of Leeton**” Presentation allows visitors to try locally grown products and learn how they are produced and packaged in Leeton for sale all around the world. There will be time to look around the Tourist Centre prior to lunch at the **Soldiers Club**. After lunch we enjoy a tour of the **Roxy Theatre** With its beautiful Art Deco design and grand interior, The Roxy Community Theatre is one of the **oldest cinemas in Australia**. Opened in the heyday era of film, the **iconic Leeton landmark** is steeped in history – and its charm, elegance and ambiance continue to be drawcards today.

Day 3. Saturday 31 March 2018

Today after breakfast we take a short drive to the **Parkside Cottage Museum**. The collection is varied with a set of silver ingots marking 1,000 years of English monarchy and one of the most celebrated items on display is the scarlet coloured merino cloak, the only one of its kind in the world. It was made from the first bale of wool sent to England by the Macarthur family in 1816. After Lunch today, which is catered for by the **Local CWA ladies**, we line the main street to watch the McDonalds Festival Parade The parade will feature bright and imaginative floats from all sectors of the community and in all shapes and sizes. After the parade peruse the amazing artworks made using rice and rice materials on display in Pine Avenue shop windows. Our next stop is to **Lilly Pilly Estate Wines**, it has a diverse range of wines from dry to sweet, including dessert and fortified wines. Wine Maker Robert Fiumara has won over 1000 awards, along with a range of red and white wines including Tramillon® and Red Velvet®, which are both unique to the winery. We will have a wine presentation and the opportunity to purchase both the wine and a selection of gourmet foods.

Day 4. Sunday 1 April 2018:

This morning after breakfast we travel to **Murrumbidgee** to visit the **Antique Rocking Horse Restoration Display**. View the magnificent display of old Australian and English wooden rocking horses restored to the traditional dapple grey finish of the English horses of the past. Next it's off to lunch at **Leeton's Longest Lunch**, now one of the highlights of the Festival program. Enjoy a family style long lunch in **Montford Park**, dining on authentic, home-cooked Italian cuisine at two long tables. Entertainment will be provided and BYO drinks are encouraged. Before returning to the motel we visit the **Whitton Court House and Historical Museum**. This museum consists of the former Whitton Courthouse building, Lock Up and Lock Up Keepers Quarters. Later additions were the butcher shop and the former Railway Station building which was relocated to the site in 1983. This complex of buildings now houses a wonderful collection of photos, memorabilia and machinery from a bygone era.

Day 5. Monday 2 April 2015: Narrandera – Home
