

# The Itinerary

## Day 1. Saturday 1 June 2019: Home – Goulburn

Dinner

This morning we pick you up from home and travel south on the Southern Motorway to Goulburn, the first inland city in Australia. Upon arrival in Goulburn we will have lunch at your own cost. After lunch, will visit **St Peter & Paul's Old Cathedral** for a **Guided Tour** with one of their Historians. Several types of stones were used in the Cathedral's construction. The most significant of these was **diorite porphyrite**, a very hard green stone from a quarry on the Bungonia Road. The use of the green porphyry stone makes this the **only Greenstone Cathedral in the world**. This traditional Gothic Cathedral displays many fine stained glass windows and the interior building contains a Pugin lectern, Baptismal font, brass candlesticks, vases, Tabernacle doors and statues. A feature of the Cathedral is the W. Hill organ, recognised as one of the finest in Australia.

This afternoon we visit the **Old Goulburn Brewery** for a tour and history lesson on how to make beer and on how this industry was important to the development of the area. There is also an opportunity to purchase a beer or two. **Old Goulburn Brewery** is a heritage-listed brewery, designed by Francis Greenway and built from 1836 – 1840 as a brewery and mill. After the brewery we check into our motel to relax before enjoying a traditional **Yuletide Dinner**. If you like, you can **hand make a hat** for the **Yulefest hat parade**. This is quite fun and the winner is selected by everyone, a very small prize is awarded to the winner.

### History of the Yulefest

The Yulefest tradition started in the Blue Mountains in 1980 by a group of Irishmen who thought it would be a good idea to celebrate Christmas in the cooler month of the northern hemisphere.

## Day 2. Sunday 2 June 2019: Camden – Home

Today we travel north to **Camden** to have morning tea at the beautiful **Macarthur Park**. The Park was gifted to the people of Camden by John & Elizabeth Macarthur's Granddaughter. Camden is on the original **Hume Highway**, the road from Sydney to Melbourne. The history of the Camden district is as old as Colonial Australia itself and its unique heritage. Explorers first visited the area in 1795 and named it 'Cowpastures' after a herd of cattle that had disappeared and was discovered there. This Town was established in on the sheep's back and is the "Birth place of the Wealth of Australia. It has many **Heritage Listed Buildings** and new businesses have taken over the old. We will see and learn more about this fascinating town on our **Driving Guided Tour** by a member of the **Historical Society**. After the tour we will have time to wander through the **Museum**. We then go to our lunch venue catered for by the **Local Country Women's Association**.
