# The Itinerary

## Day 1 Sunday 20 October 2024 Home to Coffs Harbour

Lunch, Dinner

after we pick you up this morning we travel north along the M1 to arrive at our lunch stop at the **Karuah RSL** for lunch. We will stop along the way and arrive late afternoon in Coffs Harbour where we can check in to our motel and unpack. Here we will stay for the next 4 nights.

## Day 2 Monday 21 October 2024 Coffs Harbour

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

After breakfast we depart on a sightseeing tour of the area. First, we head to **Bruxner Park** driving up through banana plantations and avocado groves to the **Forest Sky Pier**. The Forest Sky Pier is located on an escarpment 310 metres above Coffs Harbour offering views out to the coast; on a clear day you can see 100km to the south. Returning to town we visit **the Clog Barn** for morning tea. Here we can experience the colour and charm of Holland, as we witness a clog making demonstration and see the miniature **Dutch village**. From here we head north of Coffs Harbour to the coastal town of **Woolgoolga** where we have lunch at the local services club, then visit the **Sikh Heritage Museum**, located within the **Guru Nanak Sikh Temple**. The temple was built by the town's Sikh residents whose ancestors travelled to the North Coast around the time of Australian Federation

## Day 3 Tuesday 22 October 2024 Urunga

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

This morning we are off to **Vitality Bloom Nursery** for the annual Koi, Bonsai and Bromeliad exhibition. We wander through the gardens and have morning tea in the **secret Garden Café**. From here we head to **Urunga** where we can take in the beautiful surroundings of the Urunga **Timber Boardwalk** which passes the Kalang and Bellinger Rivers before heading to the Pacific Ocean. Our lunch today is at the **Anchors Wharf Café** and on our way back to Coffs Harbour we visit **the Honey Place** for a talk and chance to look through the store.

## Day 4 Wednesday 23 October 2024 Grafton

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Our touring today takes us north to **Grafton**. As early as 1866 Grafton council resolved to consider by-laws for the planting and preserving of trees and shrubs in the streets and recreation grounds. The most famous of the trees is of course the **Jacaranda tree** - the Jacarandas flower at this time each year providing a spectacular setting. On arrival we visit **Shaeffer House**, now home to the **Clarence River Historical Society**, the oldest historical society in the country. Built from 1901 to 1903, the homestead was built by the son of a pioneer German family, Mr Frederick Schaeffer, who was the town's first architect. We have a tour and morning tea here before we meet a **local guide** that will take us on a town tour of Grafton looking at the Jacaranda Trees and visiting the **stunning Christ Church Cathedral**. Our lunch today is at the **Grafton District Services Club** and this afternoon we venture just out of Grafton to the **Alumny Creek School Museum**. This heritage award winning school museum is a tribute to the bygone era of one-teacher schools of the 1930s. Retaining much of its original character and charm, the schoolhouse experience comes complete with blackboard and easel, desks with inkwells, Metters Fuel Stove, teacher's desk and aids, including the much feared cane. Late afternoon we arrive back in Coffs Harbour and relax before dinner

We stop for morning tea at **Ricardo's Tomatoes and Strawberries** just on the outskirts of Port Macquarie, then again for lunch (own expense) along the way, arriving home in the afternoon with many wonderful memories of our 5 day holiday in Coffs Harbour with Brian and Mary and Ezi Drive Coaches.

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
