The Itinerary

Day 1 Thu 25 March 2027 Home to Tamworth

Lunch, Dinner

Following our morning pick-ups, we farewell Sydney and travel north along the M1 Motorway to Tamworth for Easter. Today is a leisurely travel day so sit back and relax. Lunch today is at the **Kurri Kurri Bowls Club** and this afternoon we stop in Scone and visit the **Hunter Warbirds Museum**. Hunter Warbirds displays a collection of the most significant fighter and trainer aircraft from the Australian Flying Corp and the RAAF. The exhibition captures the significance of aviation in the Hunter Region and Australia, as well as around the world. From here we head to Tamworth and check into our accommodation and freshen up for dinner at the Ibis Styles Tamworth – 4 nights

Day 2 Fri 26 March 2027 Walcha

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

After breakfast, our sightseeing takes us west to Walcha, claimed to be New England's oldest town. The area is a significant primary producing area and known to produce high quality native hardwoods. A **local guide** will join us on coach for a **tour of the township**. Next is a visit to the **Langford Homestead** the original location of explorer John Oxley's campsite. Langford is a grand two storey building built in 1903 featuring 22 rooms and a 5 storey central tower overlooking the circular entrance and extensive surrounding gardens. We enjoy an indulgent **High Tea** in the homestead before our afternoon visit to the **Walcha Pioneer Cottage Museum**, a complex comprising a variety of historical buildings on the original land grant of 1858 to Constable Buckland. The complex includes his house built in the 1860s of slabs with shingle roof. The grounds have a stringy bark tree trunk carved by local aborigines which is fascinating workmanship.

Day 3 Sat 27 March 2027 Tamworth Attractions

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

This morning we get to know Tamworth and welcome a **local tour guide** on board the coach for a tour of the local area. Next, we take a look through the **Tamworth Power Station Museum**. Power is important to the Tamworth's history as it became the first city in Australia to be lit by municipal electric street lighting. Here we explore the history of innovation, and the important role electricity plays in our everyday lives at Australia's only dedicated **electrical museum**. Its lunch time and we now head to the **Big Golden Guitar Centre**. Along with the information centre it also houses the **National Guitar Museum** that has an impressive collection of guitars from all across the world. This afternoon we visit the **Walk a Country Mile** and **The Australian Country Music Hall of Fame**. Learn all about the story of Australian country music. From the welcome introduction by multi-award-winning actor and Australian icon Jack Thompson, we will experience fascinating exhibits, audio visual presentations and an amazing display of memorabilia. Many of Australia's major country music stars, past and present, are represented in the displays and many have supplied their own special souvenirs and keepsakes to make this exhibition a very special experience.

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Day 4 Sun 28 March 2027 Nundle

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Happy Easter! This morning we head south to the small town of Quirindi for a visit to Bob's Shed. for morning tea and cake. Here we take a stroll down memory lane where you can find an old time General Store stocked with authentic 40s and 50s items, admire the collection of historic pub items in the **Railway Hotel** and visit **Peter Brocks World** - an amazing tribute to an Australian icon. For lunch we make our way to the small town of **Nundle**, located about 45 minutes Southeast of Tamworth. Nundle was established when gold was discovered in 1852. This very scenic town has many historic buildings including the **Nundle Woollen Mill**, the Old Court House and the Methodist Church. For lunch we visit the **Mount Misery Gold Mine Café** and then have a look through the **gold mine museum**. We have a look through the Nundle Woollen Mill and return to Tamworth this afternoon for some free time before dinner.

Day 5 Mon 29 March 2027 Home

Departing Tamworth, we begin our journey home with our lunch at the **Hunter Belle Cheese** education and tasting experience. Hunter Belle Cheese is a producer of unique, high quality gourmet cheese products. All the cheeses are handmade exclusively from the milk of Brown Swiss cows in the Upper Hunter Valley of NSW. Then we continue south to home to say good bye at your door after a wonderful Easter with Brian and Mary from Ezi Drive Coaches, Holiday Coach Tours.

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
