The Itinerary

Day 1 Sun 21 Feb 2027 Home to Batemans Bay

Lunch, Dinner

This morning we board the coach and head south toward the M5 Motorway and through the Illawarra region to Kiama where we stop for lunch at the **Kiama Bowls Club**, then visit the **Kiama Blowhole**. We look through the **Pilots Cottage Museum** straight after lunch. This afternoon our journey sees us driving through Ulladulla to Batemans Bay, where we can unpack and settle in for the next 4 nights.

Sunseeker Motor Inn, Batemans Bay

Day 2 Mon 22 Feb 2027 Mogo Zoo & Batehaven

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Following breakfast, we travel through the coastal section of Batemans Bay to the **Mogo Wildlife Park**. The Zoo was deeply impacted by the 2019 bushfires with several animals taken home by keepers for refuge. The Zoo has been recovering from the fires and there are lions, tigers, jaguars, snow leopards (the only breeding pair in the country), a variety of monkeys, red pandas, small clawed otters to mention just some of the animals you will meet today. We spend the morning here and have morning tea and some free time to look at the various animals. From Mogo we now head to the coastal town of Tomakin for lunch at the **Tomakin Sports Club** and this afternoon we head south to Moruya to take in the views from the **Moruya Heads Lookout** before arriving back at our hotel late afternoon.

Day 3 Tue 23 Feb 2027 Batemans Bay & Clyde River

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Following breakfast, we travel via Moruya to **Narooma** where we board **the Wagonga Princess** for a **2-hour cruise** on the **Wagonga Inlet**. Our cruise takes place on the sheltered Wagonga Inlet where we learn about the local flora and fauna, as well as much of the local history. Lunch today is at the **Narooma Golf Club**, then we have some free time to look around Narooma. This afternoon we head north to **Bodalla** and stop at the **Bodalla Dairy Shed** for a **talk** about the Dairy and cheeses on offer and here we can have an ice cream, or afternoon tea and then head back to Batemans Bay.

Day 4 Wed 24 Feb 2027 Narooma

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

A local guide joins us this morning for a **driving guided tour** of the sights and tell us about the history of Batemans Bay. Next, we make a visit to the **Old Courthouse Museum**. The museum features local and social history telling the story of Batemans Bay's progress from a tiny fishing village to a bustling commercial centre. We then join the **MV Merinda** for a **cruise** on the picturesque **Clyde River**. See historical sites, remnants of early settlers' activity, bird life and nature's wonderful artwork. There is a stop-over at the historical village of **Nelligen** with time for a stroll on the dock or to sit on the banks of the river and enjoy the views. Enjoy fish and chips for **lunch on board** including tea and coffee. Following our cruise, we travel to **Eurobodalla**

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Regional Botanic Gardens. Situated on a 42 hectare forest site, the gardens grow and display plants which occur naturally in the region. The site abounds with a wide variety of flora and fauna with more than 2,000 species of plants, trees and shrubs. There are kangaroos, wallabies, bandicoots, possums, echidnas, snakes, lizards, frogs and many birds. The Gift Shop stocks unique Australian made gifts, books, toys, local art, regional plants, bush tucker and a seasonal range of delicious jams, pickles and chutney made by the Friends of the Garden. We then enjoy a **guided tour** of the gardens before returning to our hotel.

Day 5 Thu 25 Feb 2027 Home

Breakfast, Lunch

We bid farewell to our hosts this morning and travel to Jervis Bay where we board **Jervis Bay Wild Cruises** for a one and half hour cruise on **Jervis Bay**. On our cruise we see the resident bottlenose dolphins and the opportunity to relax and enjoy the unspoilt contrasting scenery and the white sandy beaches will be unforgettable. Apart from the dolphins we should also see local sea birds such as the white breasted sea eagles, crested terns, yellow headed boobies, shearwaters and pelicans. Back on dry land we have lunch at **Club Jervis Bay**, then start our journey home and arrive back this afternoon to say goodbye to Brian and Mary from Ezi Drive Coaches, Holiday Coach Tours after a wonderful five days visiting the South Coast.

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
