The Itinerary

Day 1 Thursday 17 April 2025 Home to Lake Macquarie

Lunch, Dinner

This morning, we pick you up from home and head north along the M1 to arrive in Woy Woy where we board the **Central Coast Ferry** Service for the **ferry ride** along the **Brisbane Waterway and Cockle Channel.** Lunch day is at the **Davistown RSL Club**, then this afternoon we enjoy a wine tasting at the quirky **Firescreek Botanical Winery**. From here we head to our motel located in Argenton overlooking Cockle Creek. Macquarie 4 Star for four nights

Day 2 Friday 18 2025 The Hunter Valley

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Today we head for the Hunter Valley and our first stop is the **Hunter Valley Chocolate Company** Twenty-3-Twenty Chocolate & Fudge Factory. We can see the huge range of chocolates available and whilst here we enjoy morning tea. Its not far from here to **the Hunter Valley Gardens** where we will find over 25 hectares of spectacular international display gardens. Sensational sights, colours and fragrances dominate the twelve stunning feature gardens. Explore each garden and bask in a lavish array of colour. Laze above the 10-metre waterfall and take in the superb views from the lookout or step back in time with all the favourite fairy-tale characters in the Storybook Garden. Lunch today is at **the Garden Terrace Restaurant**, and we have some free time to look through the **Hunter Valley Gardens Village**. This afternoon we visit the **Sir Edgeworth David Memorial Museum** in Cessnock that is dedicated to re-counting the stories and lives of the people who worked in the local Coal Industry. From here we return to our hotel

Day 3 Saturday 19 April 2025 Port Stephens

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

We start our day with a tour through the **Stockton Bight Sand Dunes**. The dunes need to be seen to be believed. Covering an area of over 2,500 hectares along the 32km long Stockton Beach the brilliant white Sand Dunes climb up to 30 metres high with slopes up to 60°. We will board a very comfortable **4WD vehicle** and take a drive through the dunes, along the beach and past 'Tin City', a small makeshift fishing village that emerges from the dunes like a mirage! We have morning tea at **Crest Birubi Beach restaurant**, then take a sightseeing drive through Port Stephens before arriving at the **Tailor Made Fish Farm** and Cookabarra Restaurant. Here we enjoy lunch and a tour of the **Barramundi Farm**. This afternoon we take a sightseeing drive past Fort Wallace and the suburb of Stockton where we can take in the views of the Hunter River and Newcastle Harbour before returning to our motel

Day 4 Sunday 20 April 2025 Hunter River Cruise

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

We enjoy a relaxed breakfast, then make our way into Newcastle with a brief sightseeing drive passing Newcastle Beach, Fort Scratchley and the Esplanade. Mid-morning we board **Nova Cruises** for the **Hunter River Discovery Cruise** to Raymond Terrace. Marvel at the changing landscape from the city along Newcastle's foreshore through to the serenity of the Kooragang Wetlands. Home style Devonshire Tea is served en-route while cruising past farmlands adjoining the river and witness the opening of the historic **Hexham Bridge**. Dis-embarking the cruise we have lunch at the **Junction Inn Hotel**.

Day 5 Monday 21 April 2025 Home

We farewell our hosts and depart the Motel, making our way to West Gosford for morning tea at the **Chocolate Factory**. Not far from here is the **Australian Reptile Park**, where we spend some time with our own **tour guide** to talk about the animals.
