## The Itinerary

## Day 1 2026 Sydney to Eden

Lunch, Dinner

We pick you up this morning from home and travel along the Hume Motorway to start our 5-day Spring Tour to Eden and the South Coast of New South Wales. Our lunch stop will be at **Queanbeyan Leagues Club** before we continue our journey through Cooma. Cooma is the largest town in the Snowy Mountain region and consequently is seen as the gateway to the Snowy Mountains ski fields, the Snowy Mountains Hydro Electricity Scheme and the Kosciuszko National Park. We finally arrive at Eden and our hotel for the next 4 nights. **Coachman's Motor Inn** 

## Day 2 2026 Eden & Two Fold Bay

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

After breakfast we are joined by our local guide for an Orientation **tour of Eden**. We will see major landmarks, learn the early pioneer history and the industry of today. Next, join **the Sapphire Coast Adventures** for a cruise on Twofold Bay. Enjoy the magnificent scenery of the coastline and surrounding hinterland as the cruise takes us through the spectacular waters of the Bay. Following the cruise, we embark on some touring of the region. We head further south to have a look at **Boydtown**. Today, we enjoy a light lunch at the **Seahorse Inn**. When we enter the Inn, we'll be greeted with an ambience of old world charm as the owners have retained much of the original detail such as hand-carved doors, stained-glass ornamentation, winding staircases and large open grates. After lunch, we can take a stroll around the estate as the Inn is set amidst sprawling lawns and lush gardens. Next, a gentle walk at Ben Boyd Lookout gives you a good view of the rugged coastline. Returning via Eden, whose history is intertwined with the whales and the fishing industry, we stop to visit the **Killer Whale Museum** with the skeleton of "Old Tom" the killer whale. Enjoy a video and guided tour of the many other items of interest and history. Following a fascinating day, we head back to the motel for a rest before dinner.

## Day 3 2026 Bega & Merimbula

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

A new day and another great breakfast. This morning, we head to **Bega** for a visit to the **Bega Cheese Heritage Centre**. Located just north of town on the banks of the Bega River. The Heritage Centre is a faithful reproduction of one of the first buildings to be constructed on the Bega Cheese site in 1899. The Centre has a comprehensive display of cheese and butter making equipment from the turn of the 19th Century. We enjoy **morning tea** and various **cheese tastings**. A wander through the museum will give us the chance to see how early farmers in the region lived, worked and transported their wares. Next up we travel, via Tura Beach, to **Merimbula** for an appointment at the **Merimbula Aquarium**. From sharks to shrimps, octopus to tropical fish, it is all on display here at the living theatre of the deep. Our **guide** will talk us through the 27 fish tank aquariums and a fantastic ocean tank. Afterwards, we enjoy lunch here before arriving at our final stop at **Broadwater Oysters** for a **tour and a tasting**. After a fantastic day we head back to our motel with time to freshen up before dinner.

#### Day 4 2026 Mallacoota

Discovering the town of Mallacoota we'll uncover why this region is a very special place to UNESCO. Abounding with a diverse range of animal life such as echidnas, gliders and koalas, whales and

dolphins are also frequently seen along the beautiful, undeveloped coastline. We join Dale on the MV Loch Ard for a morning cruise including morning tea. Lunch, is at the Mallacoota Hotel Motel before we enjoy a wander through the Mallacoota Arts Space, filled with high standard exhibits by talented local artists.
